The hospital can be reached from Milan by public transport by Metro/Tube MM3 Yellow Line to San Donato and by catching the following busses by exiting on the left once arriving at the station: 130, 132, Linea C – Blu, Linea C – Rossa. You will need the "Biglietto 3 zone MI1MI3" costing € 2,00 to travel on both the tube and the bus from Milan.

Milan is served by three international airports.

Linate Airport (LIN), which is the closest to the hospital (11 mins by taxi). By public transport one can catch the 73 or the X73 bus from Linate to San Babila > MM1 Line to Duomo > MM3 to San Donato
 Malpensa International Airport (MXP) connected to the city by either the "Malpensa Express"

railway service which goes to both Cadorna and Centrale Metro Station or by bus to the Centrale Metro Station.

Call for Abstracts

We welcome abstracts for oral and/or poster presentation, both regarding scientific research and clinical care, related to neuro-developmental and psychosocial aspects of congenital heart defects from fetus to adults.

There will be an award for the best abstract presented by a Young Investigator (age 35 or under). The winner will receive $\in 600$ after the conference and then another $\in 600$ when the work will be published in a peer-review journal. Those who submit abstracts need to indicate at that time whether they wish to be considered for the Young Investigator Award. The Scientific Committee will make the decision about the winner after the presentations at the conference.

Deadline abstract submission: 30th of November 2019 (midnight of GMT time)



Abstract submission

Authors submitting abstracts for presentation at this conference should consider the following:

- 1. Abstracts should contain the following structure: Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- 2. Titles should be indicative of the content of the abstract, without abbreviations in the title.
- 3. Abbreviations may be used in the body text, if they are defined at their first mention.
- 4. The combined length of the abstract body text should not exceed 250 words.
- 5. By submitting an abstract for consideration, the Authors confirm that, if the abstract will be accepted for an oral or poster presentation, the Author or co-author/presenter will register for and attend the conference.
- 6. Submission: Abstracts should be submitted to aepc2020@grupposandonato.it with "Abstract AEPC 2020" in the subject heading.
- 7. The members of the Scientific Committee will review the abstracts.
- 8. Authors will be informed about the acceptance of their abstract for oral or poster presentation by the 10th of January 2020.
